(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
C. D. Riddle, his heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the East side of Jones Avenue, outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 10, on plat of W. C. McDaniel property made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, January 1924, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 186, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Jones Avenue, at joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11, said pin also being 140 feet North from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Jones Avenue, and Camille Street and running thence with the line of Lot No. 11, S. 89-00 E. 217.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 5-08 E. 70.18 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 9, N. 89-00 W. 222.6 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Jones Avenue; thence with the East side of Jones Avenue, S. 1-0 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot was conveyed to the grantor and W. R. Ward, Jr. by deed of W. C. McDaniel dated February 29th, 1924, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 99 at page 246, and subsequently the said W. R. Ward, Jr. conveyed his undivided one-half interest therein to the grantor by deed dated November 5th, 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 91, page 578.
