(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. W. Davis, Norma Jean Davis, Frank Daniel Davis, Eddie Crawford Davis and Laurence Thomas Davis,
All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicksprings Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about five miles from the City of Greenville, designated as a part of lot No. 3 of the W. C. Adams land fronting on road leading up east side of Paris Mountain, which road leads off the Buckhorn road, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake in the center of road leading up east side of Paris Mountain eight hundred feet from intersection of said road with Buckhorn Road, thence N. 54-50 W. 100 feet along the center of said road; thence S. 35-10 W. 655 feet to stake in line of W. C. Adams land; thence east with Adams' line approximately 117 feet to a stake; thence N. 35-10 E. 594 feet to the beginning corner.

This instruments conveys to E. W. Davis a life estate, and to the residue of said grantees, their heirs and assigns forever, after the death of the said E. W. Davis, reserving unto myself a life estate for the duration of my life.
