All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, County and State aforesaid, and being tract No. 4 of the J. M. Paris Estate, according to plat of same made by T. T. Dill, February, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office in plat Book \_\_\_\_\_, page \_\_\_\_\_, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
