in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Ethel Harris Quinn;

~~All that piece, parcel or lot of land in~~ ~~Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina~~

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the western side of South Main Street, between Reedy River and Markley Alley, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the western side of South Main Street, which point is one hundred sixty-four (164) feet, five (5) inches from the southwest corner of Markley Alley and South Main Street and is the center of a stairway, and running thence N. 69-30 W. through the center of said stairway and an eight inch wall, and on, one hundred (100) feet to a point on an alley; which point is four (4) inches south of a thirteen inch wall; thence with the line of said alley S. 28-55 W. forty-two (42) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69-30 E. on a line across a vacant lot and through the center of a thirteen inch wall, one hundred (100) feet to a point on the western side of South Main Street, which point is forty-two (42) feet from the point of beginning; thence N. 28-55 E. forty-two (42) feet to the point of beginning.

The above described property is the same conveyed to A. Louise Heyward by her husband, Julius H. Heyward, by deed dated July 6, 1922, and recorded in Deed Book 78, page 234, R. M. C. Office for said County.
