All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

and being known and designated as Lot No. 68 on plat of a subdivision known as Oakwood, and having, according to plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at page 424, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Henry Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 68 and 69, which point is 185 feet from the intersection of Goldsmith street and Henry Street, and running thence with the line of Henry Street, N. 41-30 W. 61 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 67 and 68; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 48-30 E. 183 feet to an iron pin on a 14-foot alley; thence along the line of said 14-foot alley, S. 41-30 E. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-30 W. 183 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to Mrs. E. L. Tillotson by deed dated April 25, 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 11, page 475, and in which Josephine White inherited an undivided one-third interest and purchased the other two-thirds interest from Ben R. Tillotson and Pearle T. Scott by deed dated October 28, 1936, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 186 at page 134.
