

POWER OF ATTORNEY

This power of attorney shall endure and remain in full force and effect until the same shall have been revoked and terminated by me.

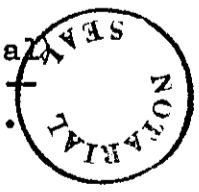
