(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Edgar B. Mason,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Fairview or Taylors School District, about three miles North West of Greer, on the West side of the Gilreath Mill Road, adjoining lands of Lee Smith on the South, on the West and North by other lands of myself, and on the East by the Gilreath Mill Road, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from S. D. Suddeth November 20th, 1909 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 5 at page 188, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on an iron pin on the West side of the Gilreath Mill Road, corner of lot previously sold by me to Edgar B. Mason, and runs thence with the line of this lot S. 89-30 W. 355.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of the Edgar B. Mason lot; thence S. 0-30 E. 112 feet to an iron pin, corner of the Edgar B. Mason lot and on the Lee Smith line; thence with the Smith line N. 87-45 W. 275 feet to an iron pin on the said line; thence N. 0-30 W. 201 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 89-15 E. 618 feet to an iron pin on the West side of the Gilreath Mill Road; thence with the said road S. 7-23 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Two and no/100 (2.00) acres, more or less.
