(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
William H. Forrester, for and during the term of his natural life only, and then to Angelee Henderson, Irene F. Connor, Ethel Forrester and Mildred Forrester, their heirs and assigns forever:-

An undivided one-half interest and estate, of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Thompson's Beaver Dam Creek, waters of Middle Tyger River, beginning at (formerly) L. D. Bates' corner on the Rutherford Road, and runs thence up the Factory Road with the former J. F. Forrester line, now Stokes, to a stone in said road; thence with that line to Thompson's Beaver Dam Creek; thence down the said Creek with the meanderings thereof to the former H. A. Forrester line, now of Melvin and Martin; thence with that line to the beginning corner, containing forty-six, acres, more or less, the same being the tract of land conveyed to J. A. Forrester by Henry Forrester on Dec. 6th, 1890.
