All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying

and being on the northern side of Spruce Street (now Meadow Street), in the City of Greenville,  
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as No. 124-A Meadow Street, and being  
shown and delineated as lots 9 and 10 as shown on plat of "Liberia" made by Black and Bates,  
recorded January 29, 1913, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at  
page 36, said lots being particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Spruce Street (now Meadow Street) at joint  
corners of lots 8 and 9, two hundred ten (210') feet from the intersection of Bailey and Spruce  
Streets, and running thence along the northern side of Spruce Street (now Meadow Street) S.  
53 E. 32 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 24 E. 61 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53 W. 27 1/2 feet  
to an iron pin; thence S. 32 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner on Spruce Street (now Meadow  
Street); said premises being that conveyed to Home Owner's Loan Corporation by E. Inman,  
Master, by deed dated March 15, 1937, recorded March 15, 1937, in the Office of the R.M.C. for  
Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book of Deeds "183" at page 228, being the same con-
