(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. A. Creasman and Selma M. Creasman, their Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Highlawn Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 18, of Block E, on plat of the property of Riverside Land Company, prepared by P. H. Foster, Surveyor, October 1909, said plat being recorded in Plat Book A, at page 323, in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Highlawn Avenue at joint front corner of Lots No. 18 and 19 of Block E, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 19, N. 10-15 E. 125 feet to an iron pin on the South side of a 15 foot alley; thence with the South side of said Alley N. 79-45 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 17, S. 10-15 W. 125 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Highlawn Avenue; thence with the North side of Highlawn Avenue, S. 79-45 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, by deed of Riverside Land Company dated June 9, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 234, at page 121. The grantor herein was substituted as Trustee, as will appear by reference to the order of Hon. G. Dewey Oxner, Resident Judge, dated November 19, 1943, in Judgment Roll E-9758 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, S. C., and this conveyance is made by the grantor as Trustee pursuant to the power and authority therein granted.
