(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Janie Crenshaw, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of Chicora Avenue near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as Lot #5 of Block EE on plat of Riverside Subdivision made by P. H. Foster, Surveyor, October, 1909, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A, Page 323, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Chicora Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5 of Block EE and running thence with the line of Lot 4 in an easterly direction 122.1 feet to an iron pin on the West side of the right of way of C. K. & W. Railroad; thence with said railroad right of way in a southerly direction 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 6 in a westerly direction 121.4 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Chicora Avenue; thence with the East side of Chicora Avenue N. 7-51 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Knox L. Haynsworth, Trustee, by deed of Riverside Land Company dated June 9, 1941, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 234, at page 121. The grantor herein was substituted as Trustee, as will appear by reference to the order of Hon. G. Dewey Oxner, Resident Judge, dated November 19, 1943, in Judgment Roll E-9758 in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, S. C., and this conveyance is made by the grantor as Trustee pursuant to the power and authority therein granted.

The grantee is to pay the 1944 State and County taxes on this property.
