SEPERATION AGREEMENT.

This Indenture, made and entered into this the 29th day of February A. D. 1944 by and between Bowen Hill, party of the first part, and Nell Odom Hill, party of the second part.

It is hereby agreed that the party of the first part will pay the party of the second part the sum of Seven & no/100 Dollars weekly, (\$7.00) this money to be used to support the minor Children of the party of the first part and is to remain in force until said children reach their legal ages, it is further agreed that the party of the second part will hereby release the party of the first part from all warrants that is now standing against the party of the first part, and further binds herself, her heirs, administrators and assigns to protect said agreement.

It is further agreed that the payment of the sum of Seven Dollars will be made on each Monday of every week, at the office of R. D. Nesbitt, or until otherwise agreed as to the place said payment will be made, and that the party of the second part hereby releases the party of the first part from all marriage vows, and duties responsibilities of a parent, as long as payments are made as agreed, further that she will not molest, bother, annoy, or worry the party of the first part with her family troubles, and that she acknowledges and accepts divorce decree as issued by the Georgia Courts.

It is further agreed that if the party of the first part should become disabled, or physically unfit to work, is ill upon the certificate of a duly licensed Physician, that the party of the first part will be released from said agreement until such time as he may be able to return to work.

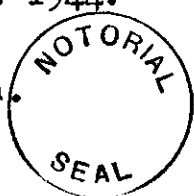
