and having according to plat of the property of W. D. Christian, made by R. E. Dalton, February 1944, the following metes and bounds:

Lot No. 1.

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the County Road, where the same intersects with U. S. Highway No. 29, and running thence along the northwestern side of Highway No. 29, N. 42-25 E. 43.2 feet to iron pin, corner of property sold by W. D. Christian to the Trustees of Golden Grove Baptist Church; thence with line of said property, N. 45-25 W. 72.2 feet to iron pin; thence S. 44-35 W. 51.8 feet to iron pin in center of County Road; thence with center of said County Road, S. 52 E. 74.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 2.

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of County Road, the northwest corner of the tract sold to the Trustees of Golden Grove Baptist Church, and running thence with line of said lot, N. 42-25 E. 340.8 feet to iron pin in line of property now or formerly owned by S. M. Capell; thence with line of said property, N. 23-50 W. 196.4 feet to iron pin; thence S. 73 3/4 W. 535.5 feet along line of property now or formerly owned by C. A. Corn to iron pin in center of County Road; thence with center of County Road as a line S. 52-0 E. 470 feet to the beginning corner.

The above two lots are the same conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in Volume 245 at Page 211, except the lot containing 1.53 acres heretofore conveyed to the Trustees of Golden Grove Baptist Church.
