WHEREAS, Mrs. Shirley D. Harris, 115 Central Park West,  
New York, N. Y., and Nat Oshan, 51 West 86th. Street,  
New York, N. Y.,

did on the 28th day of February, 1944, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is DEBBIE SHOP

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to conduct a ladies' ready-to-wear business and to buy, sell and deal in such goods, wares and merchandise as are incidental to such business; and to buy, sell and lease real estate as the same may be necessary and incidental to the corporate objects and, in general, to do any and all things which are ordinarily and necessarily done in a ladies' and girls' ready-to-wear store.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars,  
payable immediately.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is twelve (12) Dollars.  
of the par value of One Thousand (\$1,000.00)

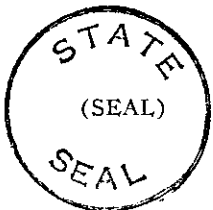
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 26th day of February, 1944, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy the following were elected directors:  
Mrs. Shirley D. Harris and Nat Oshan.

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President Mrs. Shirley D. Harris  
as Vice-President, Nat Oshan; as Secretary, Mrs. Shirley D. Harris  
as Treasurer, Nat Oshan.

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

The Greenville News  
a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, Therefore, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
