All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

known and designated as Lots Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23 of the
property of T. T. Link, Piedmont Park, according to survey and plat by W. D. McBrayer, Surveyor,
made May 24, 1937, recorded in Plat Book D, page 248, reference to which is hereby made for a
more complete description of said lots.

Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 21, 22, and 23 fronting on the north side of a public road; lots 11,
12 and 13 fronting on the east side of Link Street; lots 18, 19 and 20 fronting on the west side of
Link Street.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,
South Carolina, on the northwest side of Easley Bridge Road, about three miles southwest of the
City of Greenville, known as Lots Nos. 37, 38 and 39 on R. E. Dalton's plat of the J. R. Yown
property, and having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at iron pin on northwest side of Easley Bridge Road at corner of C. Y. Looper,
and running thence with Looper line N. 40-20 W. 118.5 feet to white oak; thence S. 74-10 W. 287.5
feet to stake at corner of Lot No. 40; thence with line of lot No. 40, S. 30-30 E. 212.8 feet to
stake on Easley Bridge Road; thence with said road N. 54 E. 300 feet to beginning, the plat above
referred to being recorded in plat book H, page 51, being the same property conveyed to T. T. Link
by W. C. Cauble by deed dated June 8, 1939, recorded in Book 211, page 200.

Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,
South Carolina, near Pendleton Road, about two miles west of the City of Greenville, on the south-
east side of Sturdevant Street, known and designated as Lots No. 27 and 29, Block 2, on plat of
Hoke Subdivision, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, page 54, having,
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Sturdevant Street, which iron pin is
403 feet in a southerly direction from the southeastern intersection of Sturdevant Street and an
unnamed street, joint corner of lots Nos. 29 and 31; thence along Sturdevant Street S. 34 W. 100
feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 25 and 27, thence along joint line of said lots S. 56 E.
100 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 34 E. 100 feet to iron pin, rear
joint corner of lots Nos. 29 and 31; thence along joint line of said lots No. 56 W. 150 feet to
beginning, being the same conveyed to T. T. Link by Ida Shelton by deed dated July 12, 1937, record-
ed in Book 201, page 405.

Also, those certain lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina,
near Cedar Lane Road, known and designated as lots 31, 32, 49 and 50 as shown on plat of the G. J.
Douglass lands, said plat recorded in Plat Book F, page 126, said lots have the courses and distances
as shown on said plat, which is hereby adopted as a part of the description hereof. See the case of
Douglass vs. Douglass for further information and description, being the same lots of land conveyed
to T. T. Link by M. L. Tipton, et al, by deed dated August 4, 1928, recorded in Book 143, page 270.

The grantors herein and the grantee herein constitute the sole heirs at law of T. T. Link
who departed this life intestate.
