(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lawrence R. Golightly

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot #22, of Skyland Park on plat of Dalton & Neves, March 1941, recorded in Plat Book L, page 41, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Bates Avenue, at corner of property of Surratt, said pin also being 175 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the point where the Northeast side of Bates Avenue intersects with the Northwest side of Webster Road, and running thence along a curved line with Bates Avenue to an iron pin, the chord of which is N. 21-31 W. 77.4 feet, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23; thence with the line of Lot 23 N. 76-10 E. 112.5 feet to iron pin, line of Surratt property; thence with the Surratt property S. 39-13 W. 128 feet to beginning.
