being known and designated as a part of Lot Number Forty Seven (No. 47), Section "H", as shown on Plat of Stone Land Company, said Plat being recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", page 337, with courses and distances as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south side of East Stone Avenue Ninety (90) feet east of Bennett Street, same being the corner of lot heretofore by us conveyed to Dan D. Davenport, and running thence along East Stone Avenue, S. 71-50 E. 30 feet to corner of Lot No. 48; thence S. 20-19 W. 100 feet along line of said lot No. 48; thence N. 71-50 W. 30 feet, along line of said Davenport lot; thence N. 20-19 E. 100 feet along line of said Davenport lot to the point of beginning on East Stone Avenue; same being a portion of the lot conveyed to us by Perry Beattie by his deed dated July 21, 1911, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 13, page 250.

And this being all of our interest in said lot No. 47, Section "H".

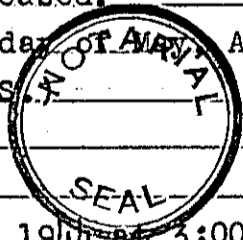
