lying and being on the south side of Fairview Avenue, in the Town of Greer, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Fairview Avenue, the northwestern corner of this lot and the corner of another lot owned jointly by grantor and grantees herein, and runs thence S. 7.25 W. 85 feet; thence S. 82.35 E. 64 feet; thence N. 7.25 E. 85 feet to said Fairview Avenue, thence along the edge of Fairview Avenue N. 82.35 W. 64 feet to the beginning corner.
