All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the West side of Mellon Street, in the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of Block J, as shown on a plat of the Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc., made by J. E. Serrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

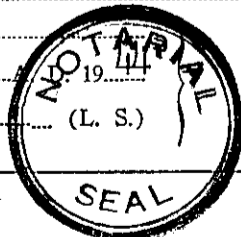

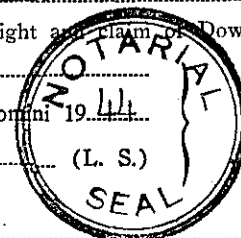
