POWER OF ATTORNEY.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular any property sold to any purchaser, their heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
