about one and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, near the Southern Railway, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin three hundred seven feet from the northwest corner of Goldsmith and Henry Streets, corner of Lot No. 67 on plat hereinafter referred to, and running thence N. 48-30 E. one hundred eighty-three feet to an iron pin on a fourteen-foot alley; thence with said alley N. 41-30 W. sixty-one feet to an iron pin corner Lot No. 65; thence with line of said lot N. 65 S. 48-30 W. one hundred eighty-three feet to an iron pin on Henry Street; and thence with Henry Street S. 41-30 E. sixty-one feet to the beginning corner, being Lot No. 66 on plat of Oakwood made by J. E. Sirrine March 6, 1906, revised December 12th, 1908, and recorded in Office of Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 424.

The above described lot of land was conveyed to M. W. White and Josephine White by Piedmont Mortgage Company by deed dated March 3, 1917, and recorded by Book 25, page 192. The said M. W. White died intestate on July 25, 1944, leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees his wife, Josephine White, the grantee herein, and his sone Loyd D. White, the grantor herein.
