All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at iron pin on Highway # 11 eastern edge of farm road, thence north approximately 125 feet to iron pin center of Parven line; thence easterly with parven line & part of same approximately sixty feet, thence in straight line in Southernly direction to line broken off sweet gum stump about 4 1/2 feet high on north side of #11 highway; thence westly with said Highway to the beginning corner.
