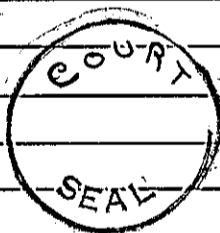

Henry Heyman, his Heirs and Assigns:-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the eastern side of Capers Street, in the City of Greenville, described by metes and bounds, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Capers Street at the corner of Lot No. 77, and running thence with the line of said Lot, N. 84-40 E. 280 feet to iron pin; thence N. 5-41 W. 100 feet to iron pin; thence S. 84-40 W. 280 feet to iron pin on Capers Street; thence with the eastern side of Capers Street S. 5-41 E. 100 feet to point of beginning; said premises being the same conveyed to J.
