with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being at the southeast corner of the intersection of East Lanneau Drive and an unnamed 50-foot street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to survey made by R.E. Dalton, February 15, 1940, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:
