All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

BEGINNING at a stone the corner of land owned by John P. Lockhart and land of Jim Blackwell and running thence with the Lockhart line South 61 degrees, East 9.75 poles to a poplar; thence still with the Lockhart line North 36 1/2 degrees East 4.30 poles to a Black Gum; thence still with the Lockhart line North 43 1/2 degrees East 5.20 poles to a stake, corner of a tract of land sold by M. C. Palmer to M. A. Richards, known as the Mayfield tract; thence with the line of same South 25 1/2 degrees, East 16 poles to a Sourwood, Waldrop's corner; thence with the Waldrop's line, South 9 1/2 degrees 12.60 poles to a stone, Mark Belue's corner; thence with Belue's line, four calls as follows: South 60 degrees, West 6.30 poles to a stake; South 75 degrees, West 4.65 poles to a stake; South 72 1/2 degrees, West 5.90 poles to a stake; thence due South 2.80 poles to a stone, Plumley's corner; thence with Plumley's line South 87 degrees, West 20.65 poles to a stake, corner of the Hogback land; thence with the line of said tract, North 30 degrees, West 16.50 poles to a stake, Oscar Blackwell's corner; thence with said Blackwell's line, two calls as follows: North 88 1/2 degrees, East 8 poles to a locust; North 11 1/2 degrees, East 6.40 poles to a stone, Jim Blackwell's corner; thence with his line and to the beginning, five calls as follows: North 86 degrees, East 5 poles to a stone in the run of the branch and also in the center of the road, which goes up the lake, North 28 degrees, East 2.15 poles to a stake; thence North 67 degrees, East 4.75 poles to a stone in the branch (the last two calls being with the branch); thence North 28 1/2 degrees, West 4.60 poles to a pine; thence North 37 1/2 degrees, East 6.70 poles to a stone, the beginning corner and containing 90 acres, more or less, and being the proper designated as belonging to G. C. Sudduth, deceased, which was surveyed and platted by W. P. Morrow, Surveyor, March 8th, to 14th, 1939.
