Patterson, as Trustee upon the same trusts and limitations and with the same powers and discretion vested in him as to other lots in said "Marshall Forest" by deed executed to him ~~All that piece, parcel or lot of land in~~ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, by Southern Guaranty & Trust Co., Trustee, dated August 23, 1932, and recorded in Book 154, page 229.

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as Lots Nos. 15 & 16 in "Marshall Forest", Greenville Township. Now or formerly in the name of Mamie Hewitt.

Lot being in School District 8-GD, in said County and State, south of the Greenville Country Club property, about three miles southward from the City of Greenville, and fronting on Riverside Drive.

The two lots hereby conveyed have the same metes and bounds, courses and distances as are shown on plat of Dalton & Neves, dated October, 1928, recorded in Office of Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in Plat Book "H", pages 133 and 134.
