WHEREAS, City View Sewer & Water District Commission has constructed a six (6) inch water line beginning at a point on Washington Road just outside the limits of the City of Greenville, S. C., near the line between the property of Victor Monaghan Company and Greenville Compress Company, and extending thence along Washington Road and Smythe Street to the intersection of Parker Road and Smythe Street;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That City View Water & Sewer District Commission, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred Sixty-Six & 47/100 (\$1,466.47) Dollars to it paid by Victor Monaghan Company (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), does hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer and set over unto the said Victor Monaghan Company, its successors and assigns:-

An undivided one-half interest in and to that certain six (6) inch water line beginning at a point on the north side of Washington Road, just beyond the limits of the City of Greenville and near the line between the property of Victor Monaghan Company and Greenville Compress Company, and extending thence along Washington Road and Smythe Street to the intersection of Parker Road and Smythe Street, all of which is more particularly shown upon a plat of said line hereto attached as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof.

TOGETHER with all the rights and privileges necessary to the enjoyment of said undivided one-half interest.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said City View Water & Sewer District Commission has caused this deed to be signed by its duly authorized officers and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed this 4 day of March, 1930.
