All that piece, parcel or lot of land inTownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
All those two certain pieces, parcels of lots of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being on the N/S of West Curtis Street in the town of Simpsonville, adjoining lands of Metz L. Gresham (formerly T. R. Cox); lands of P. G. and C. J. Jones (formerly W. P. Gresham estate) and others, with metes and bounds, to-wit:-

First lot:-

Beginning on N/S of Curtis Street, T. R. Cox corner and running thence N. $23\frac{1}{2}$ W. 50 ft. to stone, Cox corner; thence S. 65 W. 20 ft. to iron pin; thence S. $23\frac{1}{2}$ E. 50 ft. to iron pin on side walk, said street; thence N. 65 E. 20 ft. with side walk to the beginning corner, containing 117 square yds more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Perry N.
