If the authority contained herein shall be revoked or terminated by operation of law without such notice, I hereby agree in consideration of her acting as my attorney pursuant to this Power of Attorney, to save and hold her harmless from any loss suffered or liability incurred by her, in so acting after such revocation or termination without such notice.

It is my intention that any official or unofficial report or listing of me as "missing in action", as that phrase is used in military parlance, shall neither constitute, nor be construed as constituting, notice of my death, nor operate to revoke this instrument.

It is also my intention that any authority granted to my attorney herein may be validly exercised by her.

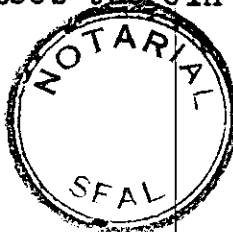
