on the 24th day of May 1922, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book X Page X

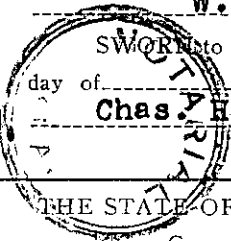
