Whereas, said Trustees have decided it to be to the best advantage of the said school district to sell and convey the real estate below described at the price and consideration herein stated: Now, therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J. A. Stokes, A. C. Few, George R. Sloan, W. T. Wooten, C. G. Wooten and T. C. Cook, as Trustees of Jordan School District No. 13-M, in the County of Greenville, S.C.

in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-five (\$425.00) in the State aforesaid DOLLARS

to us Jordan Cooperative Exchange, Inc., in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Jordan Cooperative Exchange, Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the Northeast side of the Jordan Road, near the Jordan High School, containing One and four-tenths (1.4) Acres, more or less, bounded on the East and southeast by lands of Robert Reid, and on all other sides by said Jordan Road and other lands of Jordan School District, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in said Jordan Road, Robert Reid's corner, and runs thence with Reid's line N. 74.30 E. 536 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84.05 W. 254 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84.15 W. 374.5 feet to a point on Jordan Road; thence with said Jordan Road S. 28 E. 235 feet to the beginning corner, being all of that land conveyed to the said Jordan School District by deeds by Robert Reid, which deeds are on record in the R. M. C. Office in Deed Books 216 and 263, at pages 166 and 449, respectively.
