FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is **TABLE ROCK FABRICS, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **GREENVILLE, S. C.**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is buying, selling of cloth, cloth remnants, short pieces, full piece goods, converting and finishing cotton, rayon, silk, nylon and all animal, vegetable and mineral fibers, yarns and fabrics; to act as Commission Agent, Selling Agent, and Purchasing Agent for any of said materials, to pay and receive commissions for handling the same; to render technical and research service pertaining to textile goods of any kind handled by the Company and to manufacture and process any of the above goods, and to do all other things incident to the proper management of said business.

of the par value of **Fifty (\$50.00)** Dollars.

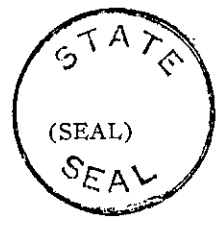

as Vice-President, **Robert E. Buck, Jr.**; as Secretary, **M. C. Patten**
as Treasurer, **J. McD. Law.**

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153 Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent, of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent, of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **The Greenville Piedmont**

a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, Therefore, I, **W. P. BLACKWELL**, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
