KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Emmie D. Goldsmith, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid.  
in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand and No/100

DOLLARS,

to me paid by The Greek Orthodox Community of Greenville a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina with its principal place of business at Greenville, S.C.

in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said The Greek Orthodox Community of Greenville, its successors and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the west side of Townes street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 26 of the DeCamp property as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book TT, page 649, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Townes street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, which point is approximately 224 feet south of the southwest corner of the intersection of Townes street with Marshall avenue, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots Nos. 25 and 26, N. 66½ W. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26 on the east side of DeCamp street; thence along the line of said DeCamp street, S. 15½ W. 73 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 26 and 27; thence along the joint line of said Lots Nos. 26 and 27, S. 66½ E. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of said lots on the west side of Townes street; thence along the west side of said Townes street, N. 15½ E. 73 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

This lot is shown on the City Block Book at Sheet No. 3, Block 1, Lot No. 4, and the grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1945, in-so-far as such taxes are assessed against the grantor.
