All that piece, parcel or lot of land in X Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being Lot #129 fronting on Woodville Ave., according to plat #3, property of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville Investment Company made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, January 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 218 and being more particularly described as follows:

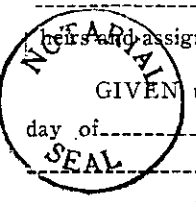
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER
