(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Polly L. Bridwell, her Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the South side of Gordon Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known as the Western portion of Lot No. 35 on plat of Looper Yown property, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 77, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Gordon Street, at joint front corner of Lots No. 35 and 37, said pin being 185 feet East from the Southeast corner of the intersection of Gordon Street and Owens Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 37, S. 10-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 34, N. 79-45 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of other property of the grantor; thence along line of other property of grantor herein, N. 10 -15 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Gordon Street; thence with the South side of Gordon Street, S. 79-45 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to me by deed of W. T. Looper and Julia D. Charles, as Trustees for J. R. Yown, dated November 15, 1922, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 77, at page 30.
