Patton, Deceased

All those two certain lots of land located on Wilburn Avenue and King Street, near the Anderson Road, in School District 6-EW, and being designated as Lots Nos. 8 and 127 of the Westview Heights subdivision, as shown on a plat of the same recorded in Plat Book F, at page 140, reference to which plat is hereby made.
