

POWER OF ATTORNEY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Cole B. Keenan, Private First Class, 304th Engineer Combat Battalion, APO 79, Army of the United States, serial number 34 895 889, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Sue Gaynell Hall Keenan, my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead, to do any and all acts necessary or proper in the control and management of my property, both real and personal, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated; including, but not limiting general powers not specifically mentioned, power and authority to sell, convey, assign, transfer, set over, mortgage, lease or otherwise to dispose of or receive money, chattels or property, and to sign and seal, as my act and deed, any instrument in writing; with full power and authority to do and perform each and every act necessary and proper to be done in the premises, as her sole and exclusive judgment and discretion may dictate, as fully, to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or her substitute, shall lawfully do, or cause to be done by virtue hereof. Furthermore, to bring, prosecute, defend or otherwise dispose of any and all actions, either in law or equity or before any board or tribunal of any nature whatsoever, in my name, place and stead, with full power to execute all papers, documents, releases and satisfactions concerned therewith. Further, and without in any way restricting the generality of the foregoing, my said attorney Sue Gaynell Hall Keenan, shall have full power to execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and Army Regulations, and to receive, indorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States.
