in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said H. J. Howard, F. M. Taylor, Ansel Alewine, W. A. Monk, J. Earle Freeman, W. D. Taylor, S. T. Stokes, W. T. Davis, C. R. Barton and W. Y. McDaniel, as Deacons of Taylors Baptist Church, their successors in office, hereinafter for convenience called Grantees

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

and in the Town of Taylors, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 20 and 21 on a Subdivision of Lot No. 1, property of W. M. Shockley, deceased, as shown by subdivision and plat of same made by Thos. T. Linder November 10, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "F", at page 20. Lot No. 20 has a frontage of 27.7 feet on the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 93 feet on one side and 88 feet on the other with a rear line of 29 feet and Lot No. 21 has a frontage of 27.6 feet on the National Highway and runs back in parallel lines 88 feet on one side and 80 feet on the other and has a rear line of 29 feet.

Reference is hereby craved to the plat above referred to for a more particular description of said lots.

This is the same land conveyed to W. Y. McDaniel by E. Inman, Master by deed dated December 20, 1921, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 67, page 60, and the same tract of land devised to me by my father, Dr. W. Y. McDaniel, deceased, as shown by his last will now on file in the office of Judge of Probate in and for Greenville County, each of which deed and plat are hereby referred to as evidence of the chain of title to date.
