on Paris Mountain, above the lower circle, and being the Southeast portion of the upper circle or Lake Circle and described as follows:

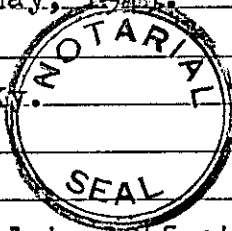
The grantees are to pay 1945 taxes.
