Cleveland and Jessie Hammett Polson

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
near the Augusta Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 34, Block C, as shown on plat of
Augusta Court made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, April, 1923, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 124, and having, according to said plat, the
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of an unnamed 50-foot street, joint corner of
Lots Nos. 33 and 34, and running thence along the west side of said street S. 6-20 E. 55 feet to
a stake, joint corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 35; thence along joint line of said lots S. 73-48 W.
227.2 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 35 in line of Jenkinson property;
thence along line of Jenkinson property N. 41-30 W. 155 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of
Lots Nos. 33 and 34; thence along joint line of said lots N. 89-36 E. 315.5 feet to the point of
beginning.

This property is conveyed subject to the following building restrictions:

- (1) No dwelling shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than 30 feet.
- (2) The facing of the lots as shown on said plat shall be strictly adhered to;
however, more than one lot may be used for the purpose of erecting a dwelling.
- (3) The property shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes
or persons having any percentage of negro blood.
- (4) No outbuildings shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than 40 feet.
