A. Stokes, A. B. Few, W. T. Wooten, Geo. R. Sloan, T. G. Cooke and Charles G. Wooten, as Trustees of the Jordan High School District #13-M of Greenville County, S. C., and their respective successors and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the northeast side of the Jordan Road, near the Jordan High School, and beginning at an iron pin on the west edge of the Jordan Road, and runs thence with the said Road S 28-05 E. 103 feet to iron pin in said road near its west edge; thence N 74-30 E. 536 feet to iron pin; thence N. 84-05 W 254 feet to iron stake; thence S 9-20 W 50 feet to iron stake; thence S 84-35 W 305 feet to the beginning point, and containing seventy-seven one hundredths (.77) of an acre.

And subject to the same provision as contained in the original deed as to damage caused by drainage of surface waters from adjoining lands of the grantor
