All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South-west side of Parker Road near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 5 on Map of Victor-Monaghan Company Development No. 1 made by Dalton & Neves, December, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at page 39, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
