

-9. The trustee shall not be limited to one transaction of any kind or nature expressed in the preceding seven paragraphs herein, but shall have the right to invest any portion or all of the funds arising from any sale, mortgage or other disposition of said property, in other real estate or securities of any kind or nature whatsoever which the Trustee may elect to purchase or invest in, and the Trustee is not limited hereafter to any one transaction, but may continue to handle the funds or properties of this trust as many times and continuously hereafter as he may deem advisable during the life of this trust; and the Trustee named herein or his successor also provided for herein, shall continue the trust estate and the handling of same under all the powers, provisions and privileges as set forth in Paragraphs 1 to 8 hereinabove set forth.

10. No purchaser, pledgee or mortgagee, or any other person dealing with the Trustee shall be required to see to the application of any funds or other securities which may arise or result from the trust estate herein created.
