PARTY WALL AGREEMENT

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made at Greenville, South Carolina, this 13th day of November. 1945, by and between J. R. Gaines, Party of the First Part, and Mildred H. Barton, Party of the Second Part, WITNESSETH:

For mutually paid considerations, the receipt whereof being mutually acknowledged, the Party of the First Part does hereby agree to construct an eight (8) inch concrete block wall with brick pilasters, being an extension of an eight (8) inch wall now erected on the property of the Party of the Second Part, said wall to be erected upon the strip of land conveyed to the Party of the First Part by the Party of the Second Part, along the Southern egde of lot No. 41 on Hammond Street, as shown by plat recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "E" at Page 146. The Party of the First Part is to bear the extra expense of construction this wall, and he does hereby grant to the Party of the Second Part, her Heirs and Assigns, the right and privilege of using the said wall as a party wall and tyeing into the same at any time desired by the Party of the Second Part.

The Party of the Second Part does hereby grant to the Party of the First Part, his Heirs and Assigns, the right and privilege, without further payment, to tie into the eight (8) inch wall now standing on said lot No. 41, and adjoining the strip which has been conveyed to the Party of the First Part by the Party of the Second Part, and to use the same as a party wall.
