(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Dan D. Davenport, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of Greer, on the East side of Pine Street (formerly Spring Street) and on the South side of Cunningham Avenue, and being shown and designated as Lot No. 17 on Plat of Property of Mrs. L. W. Cunningham, said Plat prepared by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, Sept. 12th, 1921 and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. in and for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at Page 14, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on an iron pin in the Southeast intersecting corner of Pine Street and Cunningham Avenue, and runs thence with Pine Street S. 28-45 W. 125 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 16 and 17; thence with the line of lots 16 and 17 S. 70-00 E. 78 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 15, 16, 17 and 18; thence with the line of lots 17 and 18 N. 21-30 E. 125 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Cunningham Avenue, joint corner of lots 17 and 18; thence with the southern side of Cunningham Avenue N. 70-00 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner. Said lot being the identical lot deeded to Doris W. Glenn by Earline C. Lanford under deed dated January 15th, 1943, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Book "L" at page 543.
