(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Pearle Jones Ross, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Neal Street in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 24 of the property of W. C. Cleveland, known as the "Townes Street Property" as shown on plat made by William D. Neves, Engineer, October, 1929, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Neal Street, the joint corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25, and running thence along said Street, N. 76 W. 62 feet to the joint corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 14 W. 160 feet to a 10 foot alley; thence along the line of said alley, S. 76 E. 62 feet to the rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25; thence along the joint line of said lots N. 14 E. 160 feet to the beginning corner.

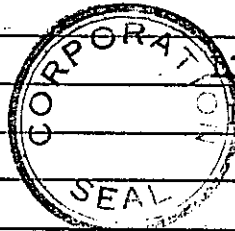

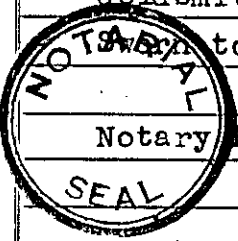
