All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy MountainTownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
on Mill Creek, branch waters of South Pacolet River as follows: Beginning at a stone on bank
of branch (new corner) on D. L. Ballew and B.F.A. Prewett's line, known as the Hozea Wofford
and J. B. Kuykendoll old line, running thence South East with said line 72 rods to a stone,
B. P. Campbell and B.F.A. Prewette's corner; running thence S. W. 18 rods with Campbell's line
and Prewette's line to a stone (new corner) on said line; thence N. W. 62 rods to a stone
(new corner) on bank of branch near a young popular; thence down and with meandering of said
branch N. East 18 rods to beginning corner, containing, by estimation, eight (8) acres, more or
less, and bounded by lands of D. L. Ballew, B. P. Campbell, B.F.A. Prewette. Also, that tract
of land beginning on a stone, B. P. Campbell's corner, and running thence S. 77½ W. 27.70 chains
to a stone on M. A. Prewette's line; thence N. 8½ W. 23 chains to a dead chestnut (now stump);
thence N. 73½ E. 14.75 chains to a chestnut; thence S. 38 E. 26.50 chains to beginning corner,
containing fifty (50) acres, more or less, eight (8) acres, being sold off or conveyed to P. J.
Prewette in the south east corner on the lines of B. P. Campbell and D. L. Ballew on December
9, 1903, leaving forty-two (42) acres, more or less, on which this deed is given and bounded by
lands of B. P. Campbell, M. A. Prewette, B.F.A. Prewette, Joseph Wofford and others. Also,
that tract of land bounded as follows: Beginning on a stone in road, M.A.Prewette and
M. A. Adams corner 3x, near the old corner of Rev. Alex Prewette and Miss N. E. Wofford, running
thence in middle of road, the dividing of M. A. Prewette and M. A. Adams, nearly west to creek
at ford, below A. B. & F. M. Belue's mill, 85 rods to a stone in bank of creek 3x, running
thence with the meanderings of creek, down, nearly South 76 rods to a stone 3x on bank of creek
near where the old bridge used be, running thence N. E. 37 rods to a stone on the dividing of
Rev. Alex Prewette and M. A. Prewette, running thence with the line of Rev. Alex Prewette, M.A.
Prewette, and Miss N. E. Wofford, 76 rods to beginning corner, containing thirty-three and one-
