COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, E. E. Ware., Individually and as Committee of Harry Child Ware

on or about the 11th day of February in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-seven exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Henry Child Ware and Rosa B. Ware

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 30th day of March, 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to E. E. Ware

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. X)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$882.50

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said

E. E. Ware, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of Harry Child Ware in the farm described as follows:

"All that certain tract of land on both sides of the White Horse Road, about four miles west of Greenville Court House, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being tract No. 7, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 170, of the J. H. Ware land, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stone, Means and Moore corner, thence running N. 50-2/3 E. 26.50 chains to corner of tract No. 6; thence with line of tract No. 6, N. 42 1/4 W. 16.83 to the stone in line of Tract No. 4; thence along line of Tracts Nos. 4 and 3, crossing White Horse Road, S. 57 1/2 W. 13.50, S. 57-1/8 W. 8.75 to stone in line of Tract No. 3; thence S. 29 E. 19.70 to the beginning corner, containing 45 acres, more or less."
