All that lot of land on the south side of Patterson Street known and designated as Lot No. 14, as shown by plat, and near the northwestern City Limits of Greenville, S. C., in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on Patterson Street, which said pin is 257.4 feet east of the intersection of Patterson Street with Hampton Avenue; and running south 38° - 24' east for 118 feet to an iron pin; thence north 46° - 05' east for 79.4 feet to an iron pin; thence north 44° - 00' west for 117.4 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Patterson Street; thence south 46° - 00' west for 67.85 feet along said street to the point of beginning.
