Mrs. Corrie H. Bozeman and her heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in..... Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.....

All that piece, parcel and lot of land in the County and State aforesaid, on the Fork Shoals Road and Georgia Road, containing two acres, more or less, known as the Fellowship Church property, bounded on the north and east by lands of P. K. Thackston, on the south by the Georgia Road and on the west by the Fork Shoals Road, and having located thereon the Fellowship Church building and Church cemetery. It is the same lot of land which was conveyed to W. H. Ashmore, P. D. Huff and others as trustees by Philimon Huff and his wife, L. A. Huff, by a deed dated November 18, 1972 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book EE, page 443, and reference is made thereto for a description as to courses and distances.

It is to be understood that this conveyance is intended to and does include all Church furniture, fixtures, equipment and supplies now belonging to said Fellowship Church and contained in the building.
